# CCCWP 2016 YEAR IN REVIEW

2016 has been quite a year for CCCWP! We have hosted 7 public workshops, funded two rounds of free well testing for the CCC community, launched and received funding for 6 restoration projects in CCC, connected landowners with the Home Access grant program which provides funding and reimbursement for new driveway access, received a grant to continue operational funding for CCCWP's coordinator and assistant positions. CCCWP is also working on a canyon Flood Warning System. We have held lots of great meetings with landowners to make sure everyone's voice is heard and their opinions on design are incorporated within our projects. We will be working on designs and looking ahead to breaking ground on some stream restoration work this winter. We cannot thank you enough for all of your support this past year and look forward to working with all of you in 2017!
